FAMILY REUNION Sights, and Activities:

We have a wide range of activities and points of historical interest for the family at the Cape Cod reunion June 26, 27, and 28. Friday night we have Andrew Linnell on tap for a getto-know-you event. Our Historian Lori Linnell will hold a demonstration of Rachel's book that she's put online and the extensions she's added. Saturday afternoon we have sight-seeing tours to the east in Barnstable, to the West on the coast, and to the south in Orleans. Our theme this year is "The Seafaring Linnells" of which, Captain Ebenezer Harding Linnell of the Eagle Wing is the most famous. But there were other ship captains such as Captain John Linnell (117,622,33), lighthouse keepers, and rescue station managers too.

In Barnstable you will be able to go to the site of the original homestead owned by our common ancestor Robert Linnell and look out over the land he owned. You can go to the tavern where our ancestors marched off to participate in the Revolutionary War. You can visit the Sturgis Library where Rachel Linnell-Wynn's research materials are stored. There is also the Cobb Hill and Lothrop Hill cemeteries where many ancestors are buried.

If you head to the west, you can visit the Life Saving Station where our ancestor Solomon Linnell (117,622,4) was the first keeper..


