FUNDS UPDATE

Linnell Family Association funds have decreased somewhat during the past two years but for now continue to meet the needs of the Association. We were especially fortunate to break even with last summer's reunion on Cape Cod, despite a relatively low attendance. Our policy of mailing newsletters only to those who have paid for their membership in the past 3 years has substantially reduced printing and postage expenses. As a result, the balance of our General Fund remains at over \$5,000.

The Association was delighted to award a \$1,000 scholarship in 2015. (None was paid in 2014, there being no applicants.) Recent donations to the Scholarship Fund lifted its balance to back over \$2,000. Hopefully, LFA members will continue to fund this worthy program and keep it operating well into the future. After all, the youth are our future!

Although the Gravestone Fund has barely grown in several years, it contains enough money to put a deposit on a new headstone replacement project. Several proposals have been considered, though no decision has yet been made.
